PROPOSED TIMELINE:

- June 2011 = 09-10 Honors awarded
- June 30, 2011 = New application and criteria for 4-H Achievement Program to Agents/On-line.
The new applications will be used in program year 2011-12 and turned in Dec. 15, 2012.
- September 2011 - August 2012 = 4-H Achievement Awards application/criteria implemented.
- December 2011 = 10-11 County Honors Summary Forms due to State Office. (Current Honors Applications used in 2010-2011)
- March 2012 = 10-11 Interviews based on current system.
- May 15, 2012 = 10-11 Congress Delegates submitted based on current system.
- June 2012 = 10-11 Honors awarded
- December 15, 2012 = Deadline for New Achievement Program
- March 2013 = 11-12 March 2012 = 10-11 Silver and Gold interviews.
- May 15, 2012 = 10-11 Emerald Applications due (This year's top 10 Gold + Past Gold Honors Recipients can apply for Emerald).
- May 30, 2012 = Top 15 Emerald Applicants Notified
- June 2012 = 10-11 Emerald Interviews /First Achievement Awards presented
