<u>RULES</u>

1. Exhibitors must abide by the general rules for the Kentucky State Fair 4-H/FFA Youth Livestock shows.

- 2. All animals must have an approved Health Certificate. For more information, or to verify health requirements, please call 502-564-3956. Any obviously unhealthy animals may result in the entire herd's disqualification from the show, subject
- to the ruling of the show committee and/or the official veterinarian.
- 3. Any goats shown with horns are strictly at the owner's risk!
- 4. Any doe over 24 months that has never freshened shall not be shown.
- Pre-registration will be required using online entry system. Scratches will be allowed day of show.

- 6. Age of animals will be computed from day of show.
- 7. All entries in the Market Meat Goat division must still have their milk teeth.
- 8. Commercial doe classes maximum age is yearling
- 9. Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes as necessary.
- 10. All premiums will be mailed.

11. Novice exhibitors will compete in regular classes for each division of show. Showmanship is only division that novice exhibitors will show separately.
