



Participants will cure one ham over the course of the next eight months.

 The tentative date to start is January 15, 2024, participants receive their ham and are responsible for trimming and applying a curing mixture to each ham.

 The cure will be pre-made (from Finchville Farms) and will consist of salt, sugar, and spices.

 Hams will then be hung in the Mercer County Country Ham Barn and will be monitored for the next eight months.

 In May, participants will meet again and wash hams and rehang them in ham socks.

Then in August, hams will be ready for consumption.

Workshop fee - \$55. (includes one ham, cure mix and supplies)

The deadline to sign-up will be 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 7, 2023.

The class is limited to 20 participants (0ne participant per household), If we have more than 20 sign-up for the class we will have a lottery drawing.

- 4-H members (9-18 years old) will receive 2 hams to cure; they learn how to cure ham and hang their hams for 8 months.
- After the hams are cured, youth are required to give a presentation on a specific topic related to country hams.
- Youth are required to give a 3-5 minute presentation at the KY State Fair on August 15, 2024.
- Youth must get 6 hours of classroom instruction to compete at the State Fair. We will have monthly meetings after school at the Extension Office.
- Hams will then be hung and monitored in the Mercer County Country Ham Barn.

COST: \$70. includes 2 hams, cure mix & supplies

The deadline to sign up will be 4:00 p.m. on Friday, December 1, 2023




