Join one of the state's finest sports programs. 4-H Shooting Sports teaches youth orienteering skills, hunter safety, firearm safety, wildlife ID and general hunting skills. Youth learn to participate in shooting sports safely. Training conducted by Certified Shooting Sports Instructors with state and national credentials.

In order to compete in 4-H Shooting Sports, youth must attend 50% of the scheduled practices in order to compete at State 4-H Competition that is held in September 9-10, 2023. Also the 4-H eligibility roster for state deadline is June 25, 2023, which means they must start practicing prior to June 25. Please note: Refer with your specific county for enrollment details. Parents must attend the first meeting/practice session with their child and receive safety protocol with 4-H Shooting Sports Coaches. Coaches will then make the decision if parents must attend future practice sessions.

### STATE 4-H COMPETITION ELGIBILITY:

All 4-H members participating in the Kentucky State 4-H Shooting Sports Education contest must be enrolled and active in their county Shooting Sports Education Program by June 25, 2021. Anyone participating in a state level competition must have passed their 9th birthday as of January 1 of the current year. All age categories are based on the participants' age as of January 1st of current year. Age groups will be 9-11, 12-14 and 15-18. Cloverbuds are no longer allowed to participated in ANY 4-H Shooting Sports Activity including archery.

In order to compete in 4-H Shooting Sports, youth must attend 50% of the scheduled practices in order to compete at State 4-H Competition that is held in September 9-10, 2023

Throughout the state there are invitational 4-H Shooting Sports Competitions. 4-H Youth may participate in any of the competitions, the 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator, Erin Burton can assist with registration to the events. ### INTERESTED IN BECOMING A SHOOTING SPORTS VOLUNTEER?

State 4-H Sponsored Training session is provided in different shooting sports disciplines according to availability and interest. Certification is provided following passing of test in any one discipline. The objective is to help shooting sports leaders become qualified to teach junior and senior 4-Hers proper techniques and safety when using a firearm. KY. The disciplines offered: Shooting Sports Coordinator, .22 Rifle/Air Rifle, .22 Pistol/Air Pistol. Black Powder, Shotgun, Archery and Hunter Challenge. - ~Further develop their skills in leadership, public presentation, citizenship, community service, public relations and team building.





# 4-H Community Service Scholarship Program

Any youth interested in receiving financial assistance to attend a 4-H activity (such as camp) may apply for scholarships.

The Community Service scholarship is based on the youth completing community service work. For every 10 hours of service, the youth can receive a \$40.00 scholarship.

The guidelines are as follows:

- 1. Youth cannot receive more than TWO scholarships.
- 2. The calendar year for the program is July 1- June 30.
- 3. All community service work must be done for a non-profit agency or completed with a group community service project.
- 4. All community service hours must be completed and submitted to the Extension Office 10 days prior to the 4-H activity/event.




