

Limit eight (8) rabbits per exhibitor

1. Competition is open to all rabbits recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
2. Judging will be governed by ARBA rules.
3. Show is open to all youth who are 18 years old or younger. **Must** be current 4-H or FFA member.
4. Exhibitor must furnish own cages for rabbit show.
5. Rabbit must be in carrier or cage. No boxes allowed.
6. No entry fee is needed.
7. All rabbits must be tattooed prior to show.
8. Youth exhibitor **MUST** handle rabbits while showing. No adult handling.
9. Pre-entry is required visit <http://mercerfairky.fairentry.com/>, no entries day of event on Saturday.
